Please note:

<u>Morris sides and amplified music</u> Please note that there have been recent changes to the Live Music Act which allow the use of amplified music during performances without the need for an entertainments licence, *under certain circumstances*. Open Morris will discuss the implications of this with the Morris insurance broker and other Morris organisations and hope to issue further guidance. In the meantime please visit http://www.efdss.org/news/news/d/317 for details and ensure that your performance falls within the scope of the amended law. Any activity which is not legal may invalidate your insurance cover.

<u>Mummers</u> Mummers' plays, where not part and parcel of a Morris performance, are NOT exempt from the Public Entertainment Licence regulations, ie you need either to be performing at a venue which has a PEL, or to take out a Temporary Events Notice for each venue at which you will be performing. The onus is on YOU to check that the event organisers have the appropriate licence/notice in place. Otherwise you are acting illegally and thus you may invalidate your insurance.

The implications of this are that, should you then cause any damage or injury (that would have been claimable through the Public Liability Insurance), the Officers of your side may become jointly and personally responsible for the ensuing costs.

<u>Disclosure of information</u>: We supply a Members' Address List to member sides and individual members which includes postal address, phone no, email and website addresses. Open Morris does not normally pass on this list to outside bodies. However, they can of course obtain information publicly available on the website. The Open Morris website lists only a contact name, phone no and email, plus brief details of what each side dances and practice details.
